On 05/21/2026 at about 0737 hours, I was dispatched to a welfare check on a male who was not conscious and not breathing. The male was located on outside in the 600 block of W. Willis Street, in the City of Kent, King County, Washington.

The male was described as a black male, not responsive to touch, wearing a hospital band, and black t-shirt over his face. He also had bandages on his arms.

I arrived on scene and observed the male face down. His head was covered in a shirt and black face mask. I rolled him over and his body felt stiff. His body was cold to the touch and felt hard, consistent with rigor mortis. The temperature at night was a low of 52 degrees and at the time he was discovered it was around 60 degrees. I checked for a pulse and confirmed there was not one.

Fire arrived on scene about the same time as me. They began resuscitation efforts but were unsuccessful. They stopped working on him at 0809 hours.

I did not see any drug paraphernalia around the body or signs of foul play.

I contacted the Medical Examiners Office and they responded to my location. They investigated and took possession of Mr. Butler's body and property.

The Medical Examiners case number is 26-1327.
